  - Parameters on how we engage Elliot - what we would ask him to do specifically
    - How do we balance engagement across Tribes and First Nations to be inclusive of all Tribes and First Nations
    - Maybe we could seek to work with the Crown Roundtable
    - **Sean and Erin** will determine talking points and a specific ask when they meet tomorrow
- How do we get more engagement from the CMP SC
  - Want people on the SC to be ambassadors of the design when speaking with folks from their agencies
  - Sean drafted overall talking points - why is this important to you as a citizen in the Crown - in a certain discipline
    - Make central to the CMP Spring Steering Committee meeting

### **Subject Matter Experts**

- Ideas on how to facilitate these conversations:
  - Will have to balance lack of understanding with having people contribute
    - Cherrypick high level things that resonate with everyone, but don't get bogged down with LCD jargon
  - Immediately engage people rather than present at them
    - Survey - what are the 3 most important obstacles/threats to species
    - Let people respond to these questions in their own way rather than showing them what we have determined - a good check point for us
  - Send out a survey ahead of a meeting
  - Test drive with subject matter experts that we do know

- Elk
  - Data Sources
    - Winter Range Data
    - Mineral Licks
    - Distribution data

- GPS data
- Process:
  - Clipping the data - this is not needed because Marxan does this; best to not clip
  - For Elk said all of Montana would be adequate (score of 5,000) in order to fill in data gap on Flathead Nation and Blackfeet Nation
    - Maybe pull out Flathead Lake
- Mule Deer
  - Summer range from CCE old data sets
  - General use and General wintering habitat
  - Winter range
  - GPS
  - Mineral Licks
